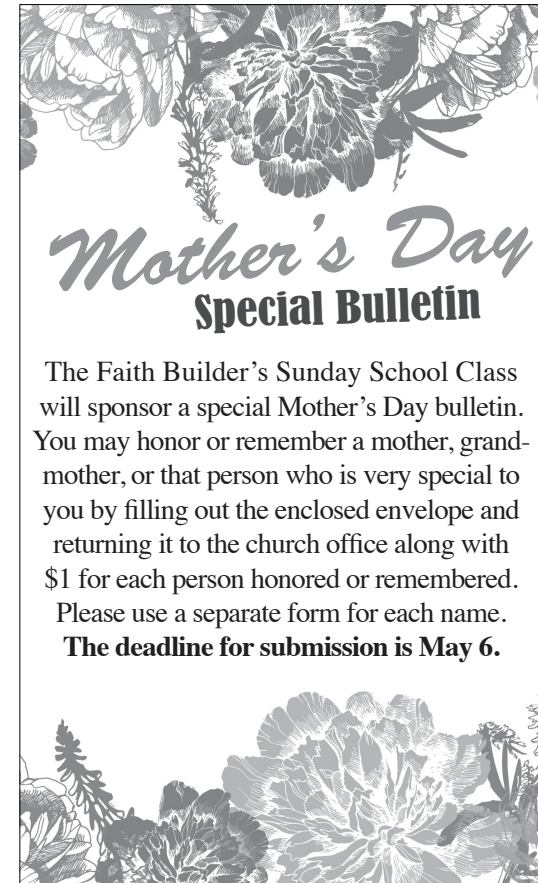
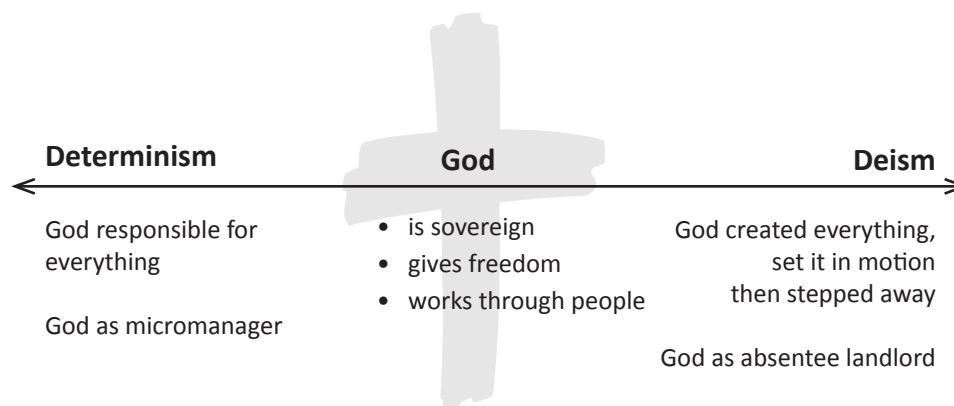
Holy Communion (8:30)
