A Task Force composed of stakeholders from all three worship services, Sunday School classes and music programs examined different models and times. They prayerfully discussed what would work best for our congregation and then took their recommendation to the Church Council and it was approved on May 8.

This is an exciting time in the life of First Church! While we acknowledge that change can be unsettling, let us remember the two things that never change ... God's grace & forgiveness - that we offer to one another & to the world. I am honored to be your pastor as we love all people into a relationship with Jesus Christ.
