Five screenings will be offered that scan for potential health problems related to: blocked arteries, abdominal aortic aneurysms; hardening of the arteries in the legs; atrial fibrillation or irregular heart beat which is closely tied to stroke risk; and a bone density screening, used to assess the risk of osteoporosis.
