FINANCIAL REVIEW TEAM UPDATE

The Financial Review for 2017 was completed on May 11, 2018. The review was done in coordination with Mark King, WNCC Conference Treasurer and Director of Administrative Services. We reviewed items that should be included in a good Financial Review and we used the best practice methods of review. We also wanted to provide an open invitation to any church member to review any of the findings, recommendations and work papers, with the Chair of this team and the Finance Secretary. Contact the Church Office if you are interested.

What was Reviewed

- 1. Our team sampled 60 invoices, approximately 20% of all invoices.
- 2. We looked at several months of bank statements & deposits to see if they had been properly reconciled.
- 3. We verified that total salaries paid matched the twelve monthly payroll reports.
- 4. Lastly, we verified through a random sample that individual giving reports sent to church members were accurate, by having sampled church members compare their records of giving to the church's record.

Findings

Of the 60 invoices we reviewed, we found 58 of them to be correct for all aspects that were reviewed. We found only two invoices with a small error. All reconciliations, salary totals and confirmation of giving records were correct. Overall the errors found were minor, easily correctable and not significant. The Church's overall financial health is excellent. The Church Financial staff should be commended for the organization of the financial records and the ease that these records were to review.

Recommendations

The Financial Review Team recommends that the Church Council consider budgeting funds in the 2019 budget for a Certified CPA Audit of church finances for budget year 2018. The Church Conference recommended doing a full audit every fifth year for church's who are completing Financial Reviews.
