Q & A WITH OUR NEW DIRECTOR OF CHILDREN, YOUTH & COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Rev. Shannon LeMaster-Smith, will join the First Church staff in July. We wanted to get to know Shannon a little better. So, we asked her to participate in a question and answer session.

Deacons serve in specialized ministries with a special emphasis of bridging the gap between the church and the world.

What are your favorite books, movies, songs, tv shows? I love mysteries and thought provoking stories that challenge my way of thinking or that have interesting plot twists. I love music that's easy to dance or sing along to.

If you weren't working in the church, what would your profession be? If I didn't work in the church I'd be a math teacher!
