PALM SUNDAY - MARCH 25, 2018

We invite those who are able and want to join us for a congregational procession with palms. We will meet at 10:50 a.m. outside the front steps of the sanctuary. The choir will lead us into worship following the Cross and Hosanna banner as we wave our palm branches. Our procession represents the palm branches scattered by the crowd in front of Jesus as he entered Jerusalem, the week before his death and resurrection. Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, acknowledging the final seven days of Jesus’ earthly ministry.



MAUNDY THURSDAY - MARCH 29, 2018

Maundy Thursday, also known as “Holy Thursday,” is the name given to the day on which Jesus celebrated the Passover with His disciples, known as the Last Supper. Our special service of music and Holy Communion begins at 7 p.m. in the Sanctuary. The musical performance titled “His Last Days” written by Dallas Holm, will feature solo, trio and group selections including: “What Will You Do?”, “Hosanna,” “Mary’s Song,” “What Kind of Man is This?” and “Rise Again.” Join us as we recount and reflect on the last day’s of Jesus’ life on earth through music.



EASTER SUNDAY - APRIL 1, 2018

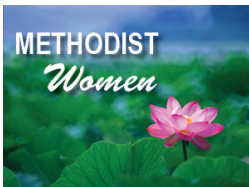
