NOVEMBER 9-11 IS DONOR SABBATH

National Donor Sabbath is observed annually two weekends before Thanksgiving. This three-day observance seeks to educate the public about the need for the lifesaving and healing gifts passed to others through transplantation, and encourage people to register their

decision to be an organ, eye and tissue donors. You can literally be a lifesaver by being an organ donor. Here are some important facts about donation:

- Someone is added to the wait list every 10 minutes (125,000 people are waiting now).
- Each day, an average of 79 people receive organ transplants, while 21 people die each day waiting for transplants because of the shortage of donated organs.
- People of every age give and receive organ donations.
